

Bible Reading Plan

You will read through the Bible in one year, the four gospels, Psalms and Proverbs twice. You will read through the Old Testament in chronological order in the sequence in which things happened. Pray the scriptures aloud over your life and circumstances to see changes take place and your faith increased. Quote the scriptures to your enemies to conduct spiritual warfare as you live a victorious life in Christ. Start anytime and mark off the passages you have completed.

2 Timothy 3:16 says, "All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work."

Introduction

The primary purpose of producing *The Overcomers' Bible Reading Plan* was to be obedient to the leading of the Holy Spirit. This booklet is a means of providing encouragement to God's people to read his Word daily. We all need to understand God's principles, His ways, His truths, to grow in Christ-like maturity, as well as the wisdom, knowledge and understanding of the Holy Spirit. Through regular feeding on the Word, we will experience the abundant life we read about, or witness demonstrated in the lives of other Spirit-filled Christians. Only by a thorough knowledge of the scriptures and obedience to the Holy Spirit, will we fulfill our destiny in the kingdom of God.

When Jesus was being tempted in the wilderness by Satan he said, "It is written 'Man does not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God.'" Deut. 8:3 and Matt. 4:4. We must feed each day on the Word of God just like the Israelites fed on the manna in the wilderness. The Word sustains us and gives us life. John 1:14 tells us how the Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. John 6 gives us the account where Jesus described himself as the living bread of life that had come down from heaven and everyone who ate of this bread would live forever.

Spiritual maturity is accomplished as we abide in the Word and it abides in us. Just like bread nourishes our natural body, the Word of God nourishes our spirit man. God's written Word, the logos, teaches us about our Father God, his commandments and life in the Spirit. Therefore we gain knowledge, wisdom and understanding by which to live. When we spend time reading the Word, the Holy Spirit convicts us of sin, brings revelation, comforts, exhorts and directs us.

Regular reading of the Word produces faith in us and trust in a loving God. Sometimes God speaks a personal, rhema word of encouragement, direction and wisdom as we read the logos.

The rhema word must also line up with the written word for it to be true for us. How will we recognize the rhema word unless we have first studied the logos or written word, the Bible.

The theme of being an overcomer is taken from the second and third chapters of Revelation. John wrote letters to the seven churches in the province of Asia. He quotes the words of Jesus Christ and tells each one where they have been successful and where they have failed. To the church at Ephesus he says, "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who overcomes, I will give the right to eat from the tree of life, that is in the paradise of God."

To the next six churches, he promised many marvelous things to all overcomers in Christ. They will not be hurt by the second death. They will be given some of the hidden manna, a white stone with a new name on it, authority over the nations, the morning star, and will be dressed in white. Their names will never be blotted out of the book of life. Jesus will acknowledge their names before the Father and his angels. They will be made pillars in the temple of God, and never again will they have to leave the temple. They will have written on them the name of God and the city of God, the new Jerusalem. They will be given the right to sit with Jesus on his throne. And finally, in Rev. 21:7, "He who overcomes will inherit all this and I will be his God and he will be my son."

"For everyone born of God, overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith. Who is it that overcomes the world? Only he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God." I John 5:4-5. As overcomers in Christ, we will live a life of victory over sin, Satan and the world. We will also inherit great and precious promises in the New Jerusalem that will last for all eternity.

What did the Christians in the seven churches do that was so wrong? The Son of Man appeared to the apostle John on the island of Patmos to give them these warnings. The church at Ephesus had forsaken the love they had at first for Christ. The church at Smyrna suffered afflictions, poverty and would be soon be tested by Satan with imprisonment and persecution from the Jews. The teachers in the church at Pergamum were leading the people astray into compromise with worldliness and sexual immorality. In Thyatira, the people were tolerating the spirit of Jezebel who was leading them into sexual immorality and eating foods sacrificed to idols. The Lord rebuked the church at Sardis for being dead and failing to complete their mission. In Philadelphia the church had not denied the name of Jesus and had been faithful, but they were going to be tested with persecution by the Jews from the synagogue of Satan. However, the Lord promised to see them through this hour of trial. Finally, the church at Laodicea was spiritually lukewarm, wretched, pitiful, blind and naked. Each church was sternly warned to repent of their ungodly deeds and return to a fervent devotion to the teachings of Christ.

“I just don’t get much out of reading the Bible. I find it pretty boring and end up falling asleep.” Have you had these thoughts before? This is one of Satan’s favorite lies to keep Christians from spending time in the Word of God and your flesh will use any excuse to justify not reading your Bible. Just what is going on here? You may be trying to read the Word without the power of the Holy Spirit to open it up to you and reveal its’ hidden mysteries. “It is the glory of God to conceal a matter; to search out a matter is the glory of kings.” Prov. 25:2.

In order to understand the scriptures and to feed on them, we have to have divine revelation by the Spirit of God. It is not enough to read them with the natural mind and comprehend

them intellectually. Your spirit needs feeding and your natural mind needs renewing by the Word. Your carnal intelligence can even get in the way and breed enmity toward God. Your natural understanding and previous experience can interfere with receiving new revelation. Indeed, we are instructed to bring our thoughts captive to the obedience of Christ.

Before you begin reading, take time to ask the Holy Spirit to open the scriptures, and give you revelation beyond your natural understanding. Pray a brief prayer such as, “Holy Spirit, reveal the hidden things of God and teach me truth. Open the eyes of my understanding that I may know your will for my life.” Now you’ll be reading with the divine power of the Spirit of God inspiring you.

It is my earnest hope that the time you spend with God in his scriptures will cause you to grow strong in the faith, be spiritually enlightened and enable you to fulfill your destiny in the kingdom of God. My prayer for you comes from Ephesians 1:17. *“I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better. I pray also that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints and his incomparable great power for us who believe.”* Amen.

Note: The chapters within Jeremiah have been rearranged into chronological order.

Feeding on the Word

This plan has been arranged into 365 daily meals so you can read your Bible through in one year. It should take you around 15-20 minutes a day. As you complete your reading, you can mark off each day by placing a check in the space on the left side.
